Top 3 Scanning Activities Support DHL Values

Verification	Shipping	Exports & Article 23 Customers
<p>Ensuring Patient Safety</p> <p>Scanning of 2D barcodes and verification against the National Medicines Verification System (NMVS) to ensure the product is in an active and verifiable state.</p>	<p>Right Medicine To Right Patient</p> <p>Products are only shipped when the Serial Number, Batch number, Product name, and expiry date are an exact match within the NMVS.</p>	<p>Regulatory Compliance</p> <p>Special conditions are applicable to exports & shipments to Article 23 Customers, e.g. Prisons, Military hospitals.</p>

Recommendations

- Involve **everyone** ...and as early as possible
- Adopt a **sprint** methodology
- Establish daily **stand up** calls during final phase
- Track & measure** readiness
- Leverage data** gathered post go-live
