Why do we receive alerts?

DR Article 36 "Operations of the repositories system": The repositories system shall provide for at least the following operations:

(b) the triggering of an alert in the system and in the terminal where the verification of the authenticity of a unique identifier is taking place when such verification fails to confirm that the unique identifier is authentic



- When medicinal packs cannot be authenticated, Alerts are raised according to specific rules.
- > Alert indicate there are products or packs with quality issues or a suspicion of falsification







What do to do when alerts happen?

- The Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/161 stipulates that "Any legal entity establishing and managing a repository which is part of the repositories system shall (...) provide for the **immediate investigation** of all potential incidents of falsification."
- EU Commission Q&A on Safety Features
 - "The purpose of the investigation in Article 37(d) is to rule out that alerts triggered in the system have been caused for technical reasons, such as issues with the repository system, data upload, data quality, incorrect end-user scanning or other similar technical issues."



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


